1. Abberton and Langenhoe Parish Council

The council charge £55 a plot (the council own the land)

There is one tap in the middle of the site. There is a long hose the allotment tenants can use to get water to their plot. The council have nothing to do with the water bill.

2. East Donyland Parish Council

EDPC bought land a couple of years ago and the allotment association pay a fee for leasing the land. The allotment association deal with everything from tenants' agreements to water bills. EDPC do not have anything to do with the running of the allotments, they only send them an invoice for payment.

3. Danbury Parish Council

The allotment tenants receive an annual invoice which covers the allotment fee and a 1/17th of the water bill. They have 17 plots.

The Parish Clerk said that the water meter is read every year, and this year it will be higher as it has been a dry summer.
