If the defibs haven't been registered by the guardians that means they won't show on The Circuit, it's the guardian's responsibility to register the defibs on The Circuit and their responsibility to put the map point in the right place when registering the defib.

It's the responsibility of the guardians to put the correct opening and closing times of the venue on the system – this is a handy video which will help guardians to do this: https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=2Fmw7A7FNo0

If the defib is not registered on The Circuit, the ambulance service will be unaware of its existence.
